Sewing Machine Mat Supply List

Teacher: Gail Reinke

Class Date: August 9, 2025, setup begins at 9:30, class at 10 until 4 pm

Location: Long Valley Hall, 2008 Rattlesnake Rd., Newcastle (off Auburn Folsom Rd.).

Supplies

Pattern: Martha by Sallie Tomato, available at Sallie Tomato's website in PDF or hardcopy for \$5.99

Note: Pattern size is 24" wide by 17" high with an 8" drop (pockets)

Main Fabric – 25" wide – 2/3 yard

Suggested fabric is cork, you can use canvas, Ultrasuede, or quilted cotton with a layer of batting in between the layers.

Contrast Fabric – quilt cotton or linen, non- directional print – this is for the Pocket.

Accent Fabric or Extra wide double fold bias tape – for the binding. If making your own binding – ¼ **yard** of using premade, 1 – 3-yard package

Utility Grip Fabric – This is the non-slip material that goes on the bottom of your main fabric. Bosal #381 is recommended. It's available at Sallie Tomato website in yard cuts. 54" wide, you need ½ **yard**. You can also use the grip fabric that is used on toddler's feet PJ's. The white rubber material with the small dots.

Melody has a sample. It's available at Ben Franklin's in Grass Valley.

Fusible Woven Interfacing – Pellon SF101, you need 2/3 yard, it is 20' wide. Gail has a bolt and can sell you a piece **for \$3 per cut**.

Optional Handmade Label is available from Sallie Tomato's website.

Additional sewing supplies:

Thread to match your project.

Sewing Machine in working order, extra needles and screw driver (if needed to change needle).

Permanent Marking pen, or pencil, or Frixion pen for marking on back of light fabric

Rotary Cutter and Mat

Rotating cutting mat & your favorite rulers (we will have some and a bigger cutting mat in class)

Iron and pressing mat (if you want one at your table)

Seam ripper

Sewing clips and pins.

Basting spray.

Stiletto.

Zipper foot (Teflon foot is best if you have one)
