

Supply List for Quilts Illustrated Travel Time Zips

Saturday, November 7, 2026

Pattern from **Quilts Illustrated – Travel Time Zips, PS 191**

There are 5 different sizes of zip bags and 3 bags that are called 8 corner zips. Here are the various sizes and the fabric required for each:

Big Zip 14"x9"x4" – 2 fat quarters for outer bag and 2 FQ for the inner bag (lining)

Lingerie Zip 15"x6"x4" - 2 fat quarters for outer bag and 2 FQ for the inner bag (lining)

Wine Zip 17"x5"x5" - 2 fat quarters for outer bag and 2 FQ for the inner bag (lining)

Medium Zip 9"x8"x3" – 1 fat quarter for the outer and 1 FQ for the inner bag (lining)

Tiny Zip 8"x6"x3" – 1 fat quarter for both the inner and outer bag; 2 FQ if you want contrasting lining.

8 Corner Zip – 1 fat quarter for the outer bag and 1 FQ for the inner bag

Mama and Baby 8 corner Zip – 2 fat eighths or one FQ will make both

Note: if you want to make them all out of the same fabric, you will need 2 yards of fabric for the outer bags and 2 yards of fabric for the inner bag (lining).

Pattern calls for **Bosal In-R-Form**, single sided fusible foam, #495-S. A one-yard package will go far since it's 58" wide. You can use **By Annie**, "Soft and Stable." It isn't a fusible, but you can glue it to your outer piece prior to quilting, or baste it within the ¼" seam allowance. If you have foam from a previous class, you might have a big enough piece for your class project. Check your stash.

I will bring some bosal 426F, you need small pieces, I can provide from my scraps.

Zipppers – 14" or longer zippers are used for the 8 Corner Zips. A 24" zipper is used for the rest of the Travel Time Zips.

We will be placing a bulk order with Quilts Illustrated in late September. Order pick-up will be at the October guild meeting.
