#### **CLASS PATTERN:**

The Piling Up pattern is designed by Regina Grewe of Kamen, Germany.

Regina has given us permission to use her pattern and asked that we send pictures of our completed projects .

Pattern papers will be supplied and may be copied to make additional stacked bowls for a small wall hanging.

#### **CLASS GOALS:**

- Using paper piecing techniques, we will make 4 or more stacked bowls with coordinating or contrasting trim.

#### **SEWING SUPPLIES:**

- Sewing machine, extra needles
- Thread snips
- Seam ripper – most likely will not be used
- 50 wt. neutral thread or thread to match your fabric
- Rotary cutter
- Small rotary cutting mat
- Pins
- Scissors
- **NOTE MUST HAVE:** Add-a-quarter ruler™ – This is a specialty ruler used for paper piecing. Please bring your own. Available at your local quilt shop or from Amazon.

This ruler comes in several sizes: 6" and 12" in length. You will need the 6" size. Be sure to bring the Add a Quarter (1/4) ruler, not the Add an 1/8 ruler.

#### **Fabric needs for several small bowls:**

- 8-12 small - up to 6" x 6" coordinating or contrasting fabrics for bowls and trims. You will need two fabrics pieces for each bowl.
- Fat quarter for background
- Fat quarters or eighths for borders
- Scraps for flowers and leaves or other decorations.
