Supply List for Mondo Bag class

Pattern: Available at some quilt stores, at the Quiltsmart website, and on Amazon. The pattern includes the instructions and interfacing to make one bag. You can buy additional interfacings if you decide to make more than one bag.

If you would like to make the Midi, the pattern for the Midi bag includes interfacing to make 2 bags.

Fabric Requirements

Bag:

14+ (2 ½") strips, think scraps from a jelly roll or a 40" piece of fabric or

Optional: 48 – 5" squares

Plus 2 - 2 ½" strips for the handles

Note: I used a 10" layer cake for the class sample and cut the squares in 2 ½" strips.

- You will use **192** - 2 ½" squares on this bag

Bag & Handle lining fabric: 1 ¼ yard of 40" wide fabric.

Fusible Fleece: 1 ¼ yard (Pellon 987F or Bosal 426)

Note: I used Soft and Stable foam for my interfacing. It all depends on your bag's structure.

Suggested fabric: 100% cotton for best results
