

SUPPLY LIST
DISCOVERY DAY - GARDEN PARTY
SEPTEMBER 12, 2026 @ Auburn Vets Hall (10 am – 4 pm)

In this class, you will learn the beginnings of this quilt. DO NOT expect to make more than one square in the time we have. The day will be spent tracing, cutting, and fusing fabrics on your first block. This class will give you a good start and set you on your path to continuing the process to make either a table runner or a quilt. You will NOT need your sewing machine.

GENERAL (Needed for both quilt and table runner choices)

- Garden Party Pattern by Laura Heine. (Available online at Etsy, Keepsake Quilting and others). Each person MUST have their own pattern.
- Quilters Preview Paper (will be available from instructor at a nominal cost)
- Sharpie Fine Point Permanent Marker
- Scissors – Two kinds: 1 for cutting template plastic and fabric scissors for cutting out your flowers, leaves, butterflies and hearts
- 2 pieces of clear heavy template plastic
- Applique pressing sheet
- Iron and small ironing mat

TABLE RUNNER (3 SQUARES)

- 2/3 yards of **3** background fabrics (Geometric prints work well. Be sure fabrics are not too busy.) **Cut these into 20-1/2" squares before class.**
- 6" x WOF of at least 15 different fabrics for flowers, leaves, butterflies and hearts. Fabrics can be repeated if necessary. The more fabrics the better. Scraps work great!
- 2 yards of Steam a Seam 2 – 24" wide. (NOT Seam a Seam 2 Lite.)

QUILT (EITHER 9 SQUARES OR 12 SQUARES)

- 2/3 yards of **6** background fabrics (Geometric prints work well. Be sure fabrics are not too busy.) **Cut these into 20-1/2" squares before class.**
- 6" x WOF of at least 25 different fabrics for flowers, leaves, butterflies and hearts. Fabrics can be repeated if necessary. The more fabrics the better. Scraps work great!
- 8 yards of Steam a Seam 2 – 24" wide. (NOT Seam a Seam 2 Lite)
