

# Discovery Day

## Climbing Mount Scrapmore Oct. 22, 2024

**Location:** Auburn Veteran's Hall, 100 East Street, Auburn

### Goals

1. Use Scraps
2. Experiment with color and value
3. Experiment with design
4. Enjoy the *zen* of machine sewing

### Supplies

1 1/2" strips of light and dark fabrics – various lengths, no shorter than 4"

4" x 4" squares of light and dark fabric

Sewing Machine in working order, extra needles and screw driver (if needed to change needle).

Permanent Marking pen, or pencil, or Frixion pen for marking on back of light fabric

Thread - neutral color

Rotary Cutter and Mat (Small is OK)

Rotating cutting mat (optional, but useful)

Rotary cutting rulers:

Ruler with 45 degree diagonal line – 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" suggested.

Ruler 12" x 6"

Iron and pressing mat

Seam ripper

Best press, Flatter, or other pressing fluid

### Prep for class

- From your scraps make a selection of
  - Light fabrics
  - Dark fabrics
- Cut strips 1 1/2" wide of light and dark fabrics;
  - Sew light strip to dark strip. For a total of 80" in length; press to the dark.
- Cut strips 4" wide of light and dark fabrics
  - Sub-cut squares 4" x 4"

**NOTE:** *You can use any color, but make sure there is value contrast between the light and dark.*
